SCALE X2

X-tra Strength Acid-Based Descaler

SCALE X2 is a powerful blend of acids and detergents which dissolves hard water scale and rust deposits from heating coils, boilers, hot water lines, and other similar surfaces where accumulations of scale are a problem. It contains a corrosion inhibitor which prevents damage to most metal surfaces, but care should be taken with aluminum and other soft metals.

DIRECTIONS: Mix **SCALE X2** with 3-10 parts water, depending on the accumulation of scale. Spray or brush onto external surfaces, let stand 3-5 minutes and rinse. Repeat application if necessary. For internal surfaces, fill the system with solution and let stand for 3-5 minutes and then flush with clean water. Repeat if internal surfaces are not completely clean. **NOTE:** It is advisable to use multiple applications using a weaker solution as opposed to risking damage by using too strong a solution.

PRODUCT NOTES: Contains acid, do not mix with other chemicals.

Signal Word: Danger

Hazard Statements:

May be corrosive to metals.

Toxic if swallowed.

Causes severe skin burns and eye damage.

May cause respiratory irritation.

Prevention:

Wash hands and skin thoroughly after handling. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product. Avoid breathing dust / fume / gas / mist / vapour / spray. Wear protective gloves / protective clothing / eye protection / face protection.

Response:

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor. Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting.

IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water or shower.

IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

CALL A POISON CENTRE or doctor if you feel unwell.

Absorb spillage to prevent material damage.

Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Storage: Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed.

Disposal: Dispose of contents and container in accordance with local, regional, national and international regulations.

Other Hazards: Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness or cracking.
